This hike is open to Adventure Rangers (6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade) and Expedition Rangers (9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade) and will include a 6 mile hike and a 3 mile canoe trip plus time fishing.

Rain date is Sept. 12.

**Itinerary:** Depart FLC at 8:00 am on 8/29, drive in cars and/or bus to RVRA, hike 3 miles to campsite #5 where boys will alternately relax, eat, fish and canoe under adult supervision approximately 3 miles along the shallow lake shore. Depart campsite #5 at 3:00 pm and hike 3 miles back to vehicles and return to FLC around 6:00 pm that same day.

**Required items:**

Permission slip and \$5 fee; good sneakers or hiking boots for hiking; extra socks; water shoes, sandals or old sneakers for canoeing (they'll get wet); a change of pants and shirt; food for ride to RV, lunch, food for ride home; a small backpack; 16 oz of water (water is available at the campsite but not along the hike); a small trash bag.

**Optional items:**

Fishing gear; hat; cellphone; camera; spending money.

**Cost:** \$5 per person includes transportation.
