

Psalm 34:4 declares, "I sought the Lord, and He answered me." This verse has become the heartbeat of our journey at the Trenton Campus, where time and again, we've witnessed the profound truth that when we earnestly seek God, He responds!

This year has been marked by tremendous growth and blessing. At the onset, we fervently prayed for more souls to enter our doors, and the Lord has indeed answered! Between January and December, we experienced an average growth of 45 individuals joining our congregation. A milestone was reached on February 25th when we celebrated our largest attendance ever, with 154 souls gathering to worship and fellowship. Moreover, we've joyfully welcomed 32 individuals to walk through Growth Track, becoming members of FLC and guiding them into deeper engagement with our church family, and witnessed 25 baptisms—a testament to lives transformed by the power of Christ!

Midway through the year, our hearts turned towards strengthening our outreach efforts. Through five impactful food giveaways at Columbus Park, we were able to extend a helping hand to several thousand families in need. Yet, our outreach went beyond physical provision; it became an opportunity to engage in meaningful conversations, share personal testimonies, and pray with every individual we encountered.

As our numerical growth continued, we recognized the vital importance of nurturing spiritual growth among our congregation. Thus, we placed a renewed emphasis on discipleship. Our journey began with immersive studies of the book of Romans within our Life Groups, drawing over 20 eager individuals to dive deeper into their faith journey. Building upon this foundation, we introduced a transformative discipleship program titled, "Following Jesus." This intentional discipleship journey has been instrumental in guiding individuals towards a deeper walk with Christ. Excitingly, we are poised to launch a new discipleship class, for the entire congregation, on April 10th, anticipating even greater growth and transformation as we continue to journey together in faith.

In reflection, our experiences this year serve as a profound testament to the faithfulness of God. As we seek Him in prayer and obedience, He graciously responds, leading us into seasons of growth, outreach, and discipleship. May our hearts remain steadfast in seeking the Lord, trusting in His provision, and embracing His transformative work in our lives!
